

Marker Text Camp Reynolds

Site of a 3300 acre U.S. Army Facility 1942-1945. Originally the Shenango Personnel Replacement Depot. Renamed 1943. During World War II about a million troops passed through here. Most were headed for Europe. A peak of 75,000 were housed here at one time. Racial unrest flared up, July 1943. Here also were over 1800 German prisoners of war, 1944-1946. After 1946 this became a scene of major civilan development.
